Civilian Conservation Corps 1933-1942

Research and documents of the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) at the SFHM. The CCC was described by historians as the most effective program developed to provide relief during the Great Depression. It saved young men and trained them for the future.

Allis Chalmer Catalogs (physical) 1905-1927

Allis-Chalmers specialized in agricultural equipment, construction equipment, power generation and power transmission equipment from the 1840s to the 1980s and was sold to the AGCO Inc. (Allis-Gleaner Corporation) in 1990. These catalogs show various types equipment for sawmills.

Filer & Stowell Catalogs (physical) 1919-1957

Filer & Stowell (1856) manufactured sawmill machinery, flour mill machinery and steam engines and still continues today.

Crowell Lumber Companies (mix) 1882-1964

This collection pertains to various documents, articles, and objects of the various lumber companies (Crowell & Spencer Lumber Co., Alexandria Lumber Co. and Meridian Lumber Co.) owned by the Crowell family. The Long Leaf Mill is now the SFHM.

Red River & Gulf Railroad (mix) 1905-1950s

The RR&G was incorporated in Louisiana on April 21, 1905, for the purpose of acquiring and operating a railroad extending from Lecompte. Its parents were the Crowell & Spencer Lumber Company log tram and the stockholders of the Crowell & Spencer Lumber Company. The last train ran on March 30, 1954 and the rails were removed by that May. The RR&G was gone except for the segment between Long Leaf Jct. and Long Leaf, which was sold to Crowell Long Leaf Lumber to serve the mill and is still in place today at SFHM.

South Rapides Chronicle was a localized newspaper that only serviced the southern section of Rapides Parish (around Woodworth, Glenmora, Forest Hill, McNary). It mainly consisted of memories of what these towns were like and how the present and future are changing a lifestyle.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains all the documents that were donated by Dr. Anna Burns to the SFHM. Mainly it consists of research done for CCC reunions and her thesis on Henry E. Hardtner. Dr. Burns served as Assistant Librarian and Director of the Library, retiring in 2002, after 42 years of service. The focus of her work, at the university and beyond, was the unique story of Louisiana's virgin forests, the timber industry, the efforts of the National Forest Service and the Louisiana Forestry Commission, the development of Louisiana's only national forest, and the development of Alexander State Forest. In addition, Dr. Burns researched the societal impacts of the mill towns and government programs, in particular, the Civilian Conservation Corps. Dr. Burns also served on the original board that was able to establish the Southern Forest Heritage Museum and Research Center at Long Leaf.
